Dear School Officials:

- Have been rated in the upper fifty percent of his/her class and **provide** certified proof with the application. Example GRADE TRANSCRIPT.
- Provide a statement of registration/acceptance of enrollment from the institution the student has chosen to attend.
- Scholarship must be used during the school year following the student's graduation from high school.
- Recipient must give the Final College Destination (address of admissions department) to the below address no later than August 1, 2018 else the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- The attached application must be filled out in its **entirety**.
