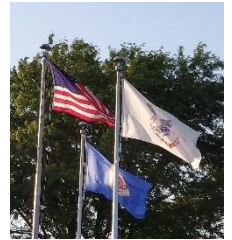

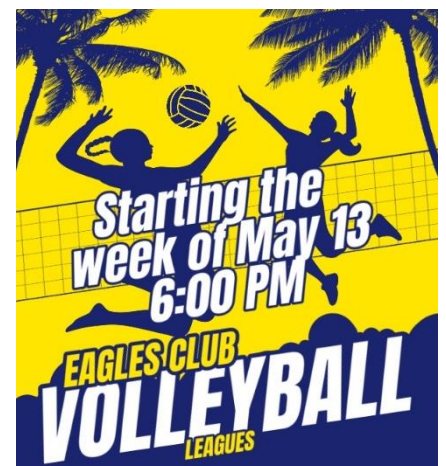

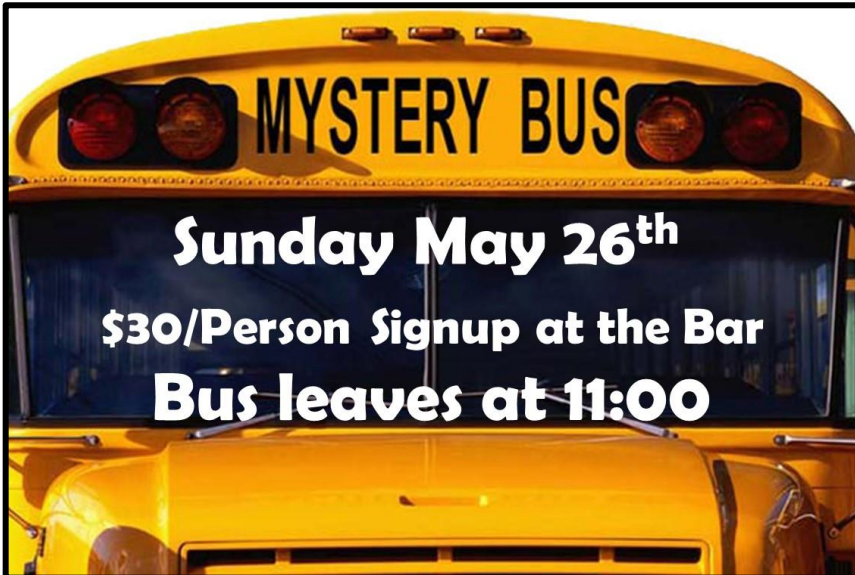

May 31st - National Smile Day. Another thing we should do every day. We have so much to smile about.

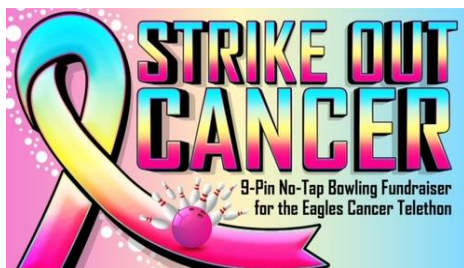

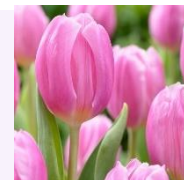
