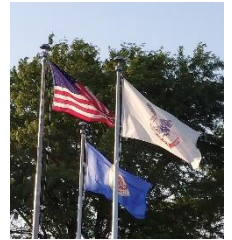

Roosevelt moved it to the 4th Thursday that November in hopes of stimulating the economy with additional days of shopping prior to Christmas. 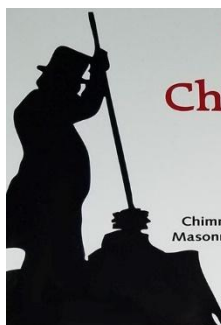

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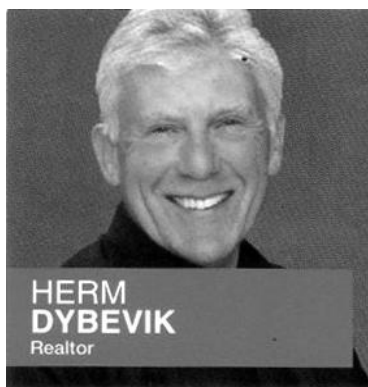


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
