

Info from Allied Charities of Minnesota Sports betting has the potential to deliver major tax relief

Representative Zack Stephenson (DFL-Coon Rapids) has an amendment for HF2000 which would deliver the major tax relief for which Allied Charities has been advocating. It would provide a step down in the tax rates over 3 years starting in July 2025, once the sports betting revenue has been collected for one year.

With this amendment, the updated version of the bill will include an additional \$40 million in tax relief for charitable gambling. Coupled with the existing \$15 million in tax relief charities received last year, the new amount will be \$55 million. Once fully implemented, it is projected that for the first time in recent years, charitable gambling organizations could earn and receive more funds to support their missions than they will pay to the state in taxes. The reduction in combined receipts tax rates will increase your profit on paper pull tabs, tipboards, electronic pull tabs and electronic bingo. Allied Charities of Minnesota has been outspoken in fighting to ensure that local charities around Minnesota who rely on charitable gambling proceeds have had a seat at the table as sports betting is under consideration. We are proud of the work you all do supporting veteran services, youth sports, fire departments, and countless more causes across our state.




Thanks to everyone that participated in the Adult Easter Duck Hunt on Sunday March 24!


