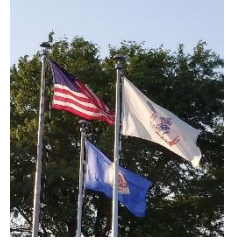

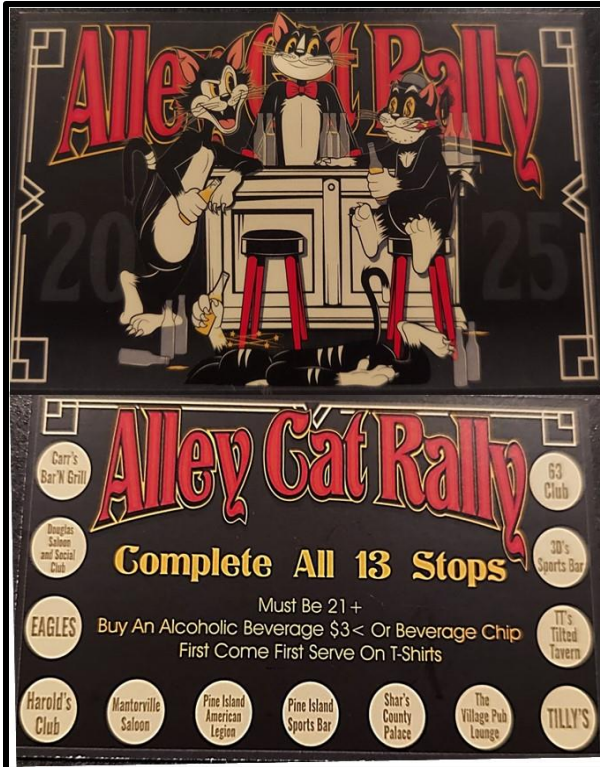

Everyone is Irish on St Patrick's Day!



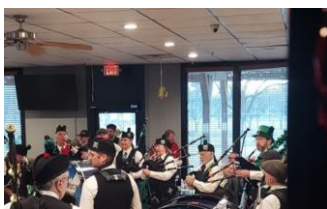
